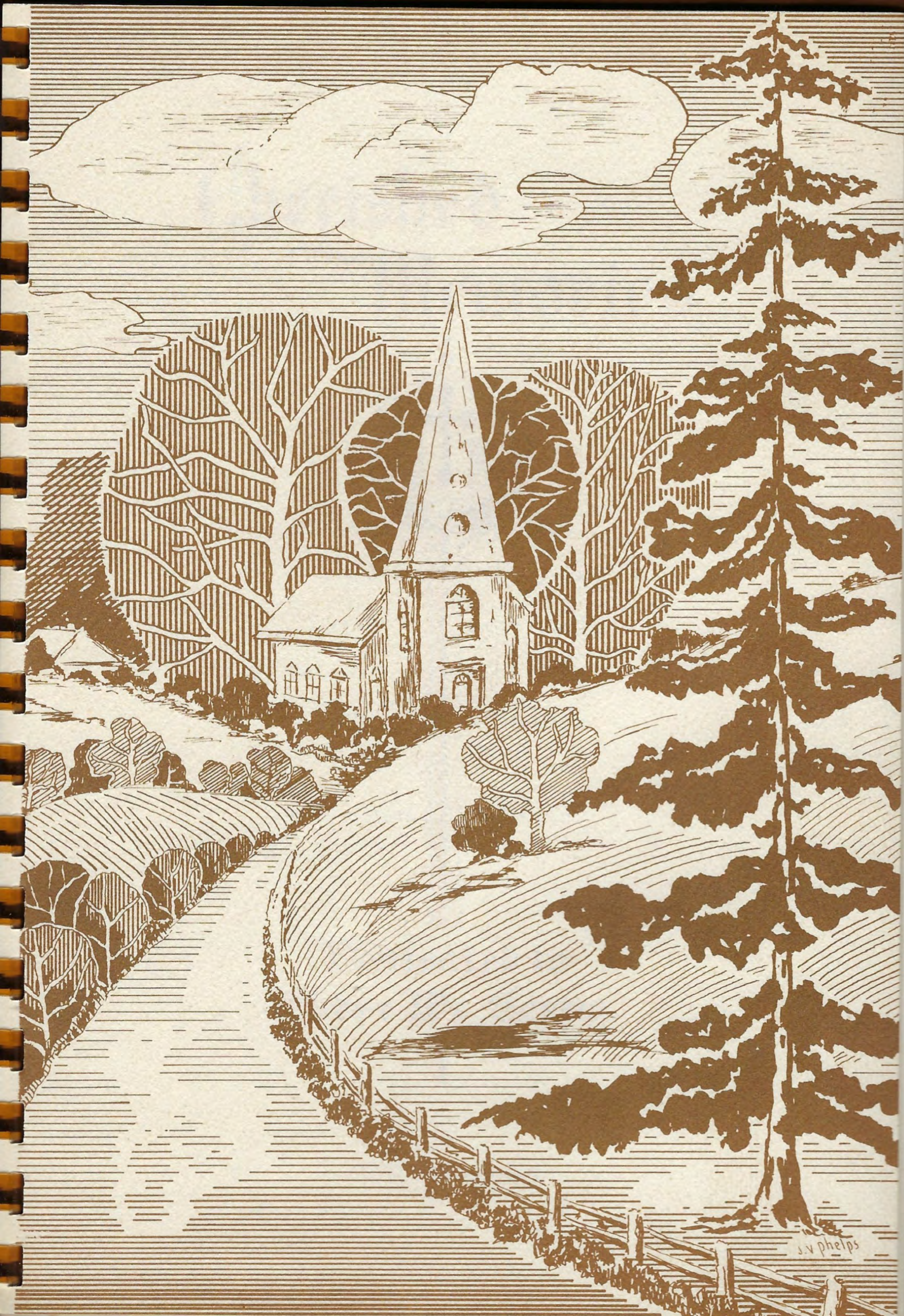

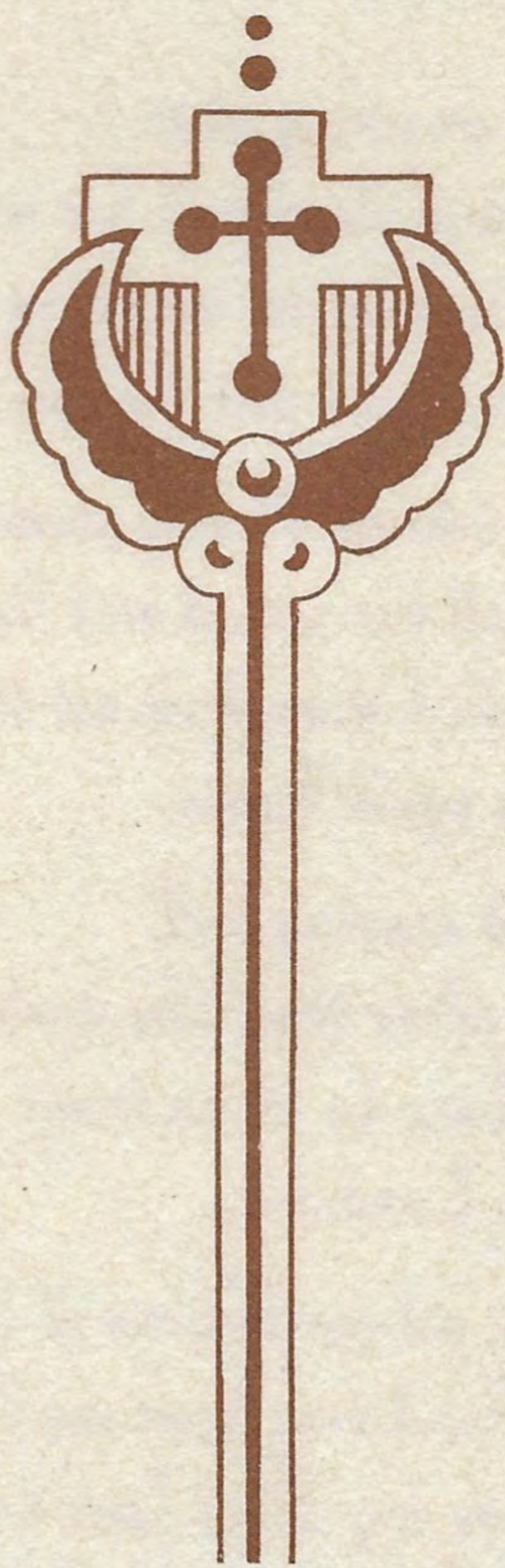

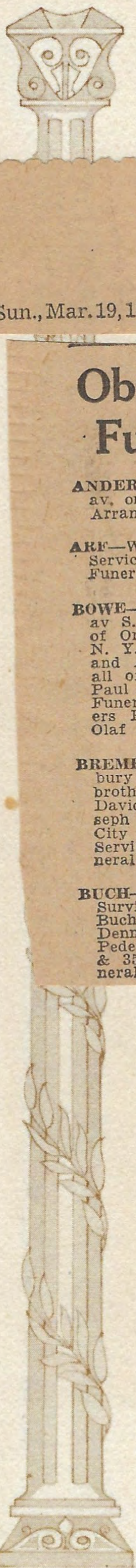

g Det kom ikke helt uventet da det i Fredags Aftes meddeltes blandt Venner af Emanuel Pedersen paa Fifth Street S. E. at Mrs. Pedersens Moder, Fru Anna Buch var afgaaet ved Døden paa Hospitalet, hvor hun havde opholdt sig i nogle Uger. Hun naaede den høje Alder af 79 Aar og havde i Grunden befundet sig vel paa det forlængede Besøg som hun trods Alderen aflagde hos sine Børn i Amerika og som kom til at vare meget længere end beregnet.

Skønt Fru Anna Buch havde tre Børn her i Minnesota, Andrew, Aage samt Mrs. Emanuel Pedersen, kom hun dog efterhaanden til at længes efter Hjemmet i Danmark, hvor endnu sex andre Børn efterlever hende. I Løbet af de sidste Par Aar havde hun gjort tre Forsøg paa at komme tilbage til sit Fædreland, endda var der Udsigt til at hun kunde flyve over Lissabon; men der kom altid noget i Vejen og Rejsen over Lissabon maatte anses for besværlig paa Grund af Fru Buchs Alder.

Under sit Ophold her vandt den Afdøde sig en stor Vennekreds blandt venlige Landsmænd, som saa i Mandags samledes om Kisten i St. Peders danske Kirke, hvor der blev talt og sunget paa Modersmaalet for een, som saa mange af Minneapolis' Danske var kommen til at holde af. Et stort Væld af Blomster vidnede om den Anseelse som Afdøde og hendes Børn nyder blandt Venner, og Pastor Aaberg talte hjertevarme Ord ved Baaren. Ingeborg Kirkegaard virkede ved Orgelet og Mr. Tusen fra St. Paul udførte en Solo ligesom Pastor Herrin fra Hospitalet talte nogle hjertelige Ord.

Omgivet af mange gode danske Venner førtes Liget derpaa til et Krematorium, og den afdøde Kvindes Aske vil efter Krigen blive ført til Danmark.
